## HOUSE WHITE WINES

- 70 **Chardonnay**  
*Las Condes, Central Valley, Chile*  
Pale gold, medium bodied with soft, rich, creamy fruit and vanilla aromas. Tropical fruit and a smooth, creamy mouthfeel blend to give a fresh, well balanced finish.
- 71 **Sauvignon Blanc**  
*Les Fumée Blanches, Languedoc, France*  
Pale yellow straw, with hints of green. Intense citrus on the nose, with more subtle mango, boxwood and menthol. Elegant on the palate, smooth with a crisp, fresh finish.
- 72 **Gros Manseng**  
*Uva Non Grata, France*  
Honey, peach and pineapple on the nose. The flavours burst onto the palate accompanied by a crisp and tangy acidity. Slightly sweet but balanced with a long, clean finish.
- 73 **Pinot Grigio**  
*Renideo, Italy*  
Pale straw, with aromas of melon and pear. Good weight of fruit with crunchy apple and a steely floral finish on the palate, with strikingly crisp acidity.

## HOUSE RED WINES

- 75 **'Silver Series' Shiraz**  
*Tempus Two, Australia*  
Aromas of ripe raspberries with white pepper undertones, which continue on the palate, with soft integrated tannins, great length and finish.
- 76 **Merlot**  
*Las Condes, Central Valley, Chile*  
Clean and fruity palate offering ripe tannins, blending with soft sweet tones from barrel aging. Unpretentious, soft and fruity with berry-like flavours. Full bodied and wonderfully balanced.
- 77 **'Les Plants Nobles' Pinot Noir**  
*Ropiteau Freres, South Coast, France*  
Deep red with ruby highlights. On the nose, warm red fruits, stone fruits, toast, vanilla and coconut. Full bodied with predominant flavours of cherry, blackcurrant and liquorice.

## HOUSE ROSE WINES

- 78 **White Zinfandel**  
*Devil's Ridge, California*  
Bright pink in colour with a bursting floral strawberry nose. Slightly sweet, with refreshing fresh fruit characters of raspberries, strawberries and ripe apples.
- 79 **'Le Petit Chat' Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah**  
*Boutinot, Langoudoc, France*  
Dry style rose, with floral aromatics and packed with juicy ripe berry flavours and a touch of ripe peach.

## Pouring classics

Light bodied and balanced; aromatic fresh peach and honeysuckle characteristics give this wine a lovely freshness on the palate. Subtle floral notes make way for a creamy, vanilla finish.

A well structured wine from the South of France. Malbec grapes by nature produce a wine with recognisable aroma of dark, brooding fruits with savoury undertones. Full-bodied, but subtle and light with a firm tannin and lengthy finish.

Perfect with steak, allowing the dark fruit to shine through.

### CHAMPAGNE / SPARKLING

- San Silvestro 'Dulcis' Moscato d'Asti** Asti D.O.C.G, *Italy* **£29.50**  
A big, enveloping nose featuring the intense aroma of Moscato. Slight hints of acacia and honey. Sweet with a fresh finish.
- Moet & Chandon Brut Imperial 1988** Champagne, *France* **£600.00**  
The aroma's top notes are subdued, sombre and dry with smoked roasted malted scents, hints of toasted sesame seed as well as rather original oceanic notes, including a touch of nori seaweed. Subsequently come softer, warmer notes of wax, honey, almond, biscuit and dried fruits (banana and coconut). The palate is energetic, sustained by an invigorating tangibleness with notes of citrus zest and citrus seeds. Middle notes are delicate with slight graininess. Nuances of pine and iodine contribute to a crystalline, saline finish.

### WHITE

- Peth-Wetz Estate Dry Riesling** Rheinhessen, *Germany* **£33.00**  
A dry Riesling with a delicate fragrance of white peaches, apricot and juicy pears. A true cult classic, both in expression and elegance.
- Disznoko Tokaji Dry Furmint 2022** Tokaj, *Hungary* **£40.00**  
Light straw yellow robe with green highlights. Very fresh, fruity nose with almond, white peach, stone fruits and pear aromas. On the palate, very fresh and tonic acidity is balanced by a good weight, with pleasant mouthfeel. Aromatic with a touch of minerality to finish.

### RED

- Trementi 'Bar Veneto' Rosso Appassimento** Veneto, *Italy* **£30.00**  
A blend of Corvina and Merlot. Bold, yet incredibly approachable, the use of 'appassimento' technique generates a wine that displays a bouquet reminiscent of dark cherries, red fruit, chocolate and prunes. On the palate, sumptuous, generous, almost decadent. Full-bodied, yet elegant and mouth-filling, with an incredible long-lasting finish.

- San Silvestro 'Primaio' Docletto d'Alba** Langhe, *Italy* **£35.00**  
Soft, clearly showing ripe berries on the nose. Good balance and medium structure
- Vignoboles Jerome Quiot Combes d'Arneval** Chateau Neuf du Pape, *France* **£59.50**  
Deep crimson, ripe dark berries rounding off to spice. Smooth and persistent with aromatic smoothness.
- San Silvestro Piemonte D.O.C. Barbera Passito** Piedmont, *Italy* **£36.50**  
Rich wine with hints of ripe fruits and cherry jelly. Velvety tannins and persistent length.
- Bodegas Valdemar 'Balcon de Pilatos' Maturana 2019** Rioja, *Spain* **£59.50**  
This unique wine is packed with black fruit, coffee, cocoa and subtle spicy notes. On the palate, it combines Rioja flesh with an almost Pauillac-like refinement and acidity, that ensures it remains lively despite its great weight and density. The finish is poised, aromatic and very long.
- Vinedo Chadwick 2000 - 'Wine Legend'** Maipo Valley, *Chile* **£450.00**  
An immediate success from its first vintage in 1999, this 100% Cabernet has consistently scored among the highest against established Bordeaux and Bordeaux-style wines. Planting this specific vineyard for premium quality wines in honour of his father Alonso, Eduardo Chadwick planted out his father's former polo training ground on the family home estate in Alto Maipo.  
A rich, smoky, leathery nose, with just a hint of rose petal. the wine is exuberantly rich, plump and concentrated, opulent and spicy, with a broad stroke complexity, balanced acidity and superb length.

- 110 Sancerre** **£26.00**  
Domaine Michel Girard et Fils, Loire, *France*  
Pure Sauvignon style – fragrant aromas of grapefruit and citrus with a waft of mineral pungency. Full and round in the mouth, with further fruity grapefruit and orange flavours but also almond nuttiness, supported by elegant zingy lees and acidity.

- 111 Sauvignon Blanc** **£14.00**  
Cefiro, Casablanca Valley, *Chile*  
Clear amber in colour, with aromas of passion fruit, lychee, and a hint of bergamot on the nose. The palate is firm, with natural acidity and notes of exotic citrus. Refreshing, well-balanced and perfectly integrated with impressive acidity and a finish that is quite long for a Sauvignon Blanc.
- 112 Macon-Lugny Les Genievres** **£25.50**  
Louis Latour, Burgundy, *France*  
Clear amber in colour, with aromas of passion fruit, lychee, and a hint of bergamot on the nose. The palate is firm, with natural acidity and notes of exotic citrus. Refreshing, well-balanced and perfectly integrated with impressive acidity and a finish that is quite long for a Sauvignon Blanc.
- 113 Le Rime Pinot Grigio Chardonnay IGT** **£15.50**  
Castello Banfi, Tuscany, *Italy*  
A balance of crispness from the Pinot Grigio with round body from the Chardonnay delivering a fresh, ready to drink wine.

- 114 Cotes du Rhone, Reserve des Armoiries** **£18.50**  
Terre d'Avignon, Rhone, *France* (*Vegan*)  
Deep ruby colour with a fruit-filled nose and a palate suggestive of stewed fruit. The tannins are ripe and the wine is very well balanced.
- 115 Cabernet Sauvignon** **£16.00**  
De Martino Estate, Maipo Valley, *Chile*  
Aromas of blackberries, blackcurrant and spice. Full and fresh with subtle toasty oak.
- 116 Ventoux** **£17.00**  
Delas, Rhone, *France*  
Red with violet hues. Aromas of intense ripe black berries and fresh plums, with spicy and floral hints. The palate sweet, round tannins, balanced fruit, intense, concentrated and a long supple finish.
- 117 'Centine' Toscano, IGT** **£16.50**  
Castello Banfi, Tuscany, *Italy*  
Intense ruby red with youthful hints. Intense, vinous and spicy aromas, perfectly marrying the Tuscan Sangiovese with the character of intense Cabernet and Merlot. Gently approachable, soft, rounded and easy to drink.
- 118 'Rio Albo' Valpolicello, DOC** **£19.00**  
Castello Rugate, Valpolicella, *Italy*  
Ruby red, offering a bouquet of blackberry and cherries. The palate is supple with light tannins and plenty of flavour.
- 119 Altosur Malbec** **£17.00**  
Solphenia, Uco Valley, *Argentina*  
Red with violet hues. Aromas of intense ripe black berries and fresh plums, with spicy and floral hints. The palate sweet, round tannins, balanced fruit, intense, concentrated and a long supple finish.

Champagne, France  
Ripe pears, smoke, spices, dried flowers and herbs are some of the many nuances that emerge from the glass. Lovely mid-palate depth and overall balance.
- 121 **Forget-Brimont Brut 1er Cru** £39.50  
Champagne, France  
Pale gold. Delicate nose, lovely complexity. Fresh and subtle on the palate. Initial fresh green apples with a hint of white flowers and hazelnuts. Well balanced with good length.

- 90 **Taittinger Brut n.v** (75cl bottle) £79.50  
Champagne, France (125ml glass) £14.50  
From Champagne's oldest cellars, this wonderful example has peach and acacia notes on the nose, a citrus-fresh yet delicately honeyed palate, and a beautiful, elegant finish.
- 91 **Taittinger 'Nocturne' (Sec)** £87.50  
Champagne, France  
Pale yellow with delicate, fine bubbles. On the nose, subtly reminiscent of white blossom and ripe fruits, predominantly yellow peach and dried apricot. Soft, fresh and delicately floral with ripe fruit flavours on the palate, the finish is long, soft and delectably sweet. Rounded, balanced and smoothly creamy.
- 92 **Cristal 2014 Louis Roederer** £600.00  
Champagne France  
A golden hue with soft, glowing highlights. Fine, steady, gentle bubbles. Powerful and complex on the palate, revealing a mixture of yellow fruit, juicy, ripe fruits, citrus peel and finely roasted nuts. On the nose, powdery and sweet, with elegant, chalky notes. Fine, textured tannins reveal a poised and vinous dimension to the wine. The finish is savoury and saline.
- 93 **Cuvee Dom Perignon 2012** £375.00  
Champagne, France  
Dom Perignon Vintage 2012 reveals a unique structure, resonating to a rhythm of controlled energy. Born out of a year of extreme weather conditions, the 2012 Vintage offers hope out of adversity. The nose is full and varied, mingling flowers with fruit, then subtle vegetal and mineral nuances. The bouquet is tactile, subtly enticing us along a trail of powdery white flowers and nectarous fruit, followed by fresh rhubarb and mint, and minerality of ash. Energy dominates the palate. After a welcome open the wine quickly becomes vibrant and then literally explodes with a surge of effervescence and a tonic sensation. Focused by acidic and bitter notes, the finish brings penetrating tautness, marked by ginger, tobacco and toastiness
- 95 **Taittinger Brut Prestige Rose n.v** £87.50  
Champagne, France  
Remarkably vibrant and sophisticated. On the palate, a subtle balance between freshness and structure of the ever-present red fruit, making it full bodied and smooth. Its strong character is also shown in its delightfully unique, intense, shimmering colour.

- 96 Simmonet-Febvre Cremant de Bourgogne** **£41.00**  
Chablis, *France*  
A harmoniously balanced wine with fine bubbles, a persistent foam and a wonderful length in the mouth. It is fresh and powerful on the nose with aromas of citrus.
- 97 Prosecco NV Extra Dry** **(75cl bottle) £30.50**  
Valdo, Veneto, *Italy* **(20cl snipe) £11.25**  
Pale gold with a sweet honey nose. Dry, light and vibrant, offering green apple, honey and a touch of pear with a tart but refreshing finish.
- 98 Proa Brut Cava** **£33.50**  
Piedmont, *Spain*  
Aromas of spring flowers, with crisp green apple and ripe pears on the palate, pinpoint effervescence and a wonderful dry finish.
- 99 Valdo Floral Pink** **(75cl bottle) £35.50**  
Veneto, *Italy* **(175ml glass) £9.50**  
Fine and elegant on the nose with a strong presence of raspberry. Fine bubbles coat the mouth with a warm, summer fruit sensation.

- 1 Macon Charnay les Chenes** **£45.00**  
Manciat-Poncet  
A crisp nose of ripe green apples and just a hint of citrus. Light oak subtly underpinning the delicate fruit, displaying crisp acidity and minerality, leading to a plump, lush long finish. Superb.
- 2 Chablis AC** **£47.50**  
Domaine les Verger, Alain Geoffroy  
Pale gold with a subdued nose revealing a hint of mineral and fruit scents. Extremely polished and suave on the palate, delivering on the focused, youthful aromas. Lovely persistency on the finish showing mineral and buttery notes.
- 3 'La Rencontre' Saint-Veran** **£65.00**  
Genetic  
Vibrant flavours of citrus, ripe orchard fruits and a touch of mineral undertones, all gracefully balanced with a refreshing acidity.
- 4 Grand Cru Chablis 'Les Clos' 2018** **£175.00**  
Simonnet-Febvre  
An ample and harmonious Grand Cru, offering slightly exotic notes and a very rich palate. Smooth with a persistent and an unmistakably mineral finish.
- 5 Puligny Montrachet 2021** **£185.00**  
Maison Louis Latour, Cote-d'Or  
Beautiful nice yellow with subtle green tints. Floral notes with almond paste on the nose that do not disappoint on the palate. Opulent, full bodied and creamy, with rounded vanilla and toast in perfect synergy. Wonderfully fresh, with a long finish and stunning mouth feel. **91/100 Wine Enthusiast, October 2016**
- 6 Meursault 2021** **£130.00**  
Domaine Justin Girardin  
Pale yellow in colour, offering a nose with plenty of fruit intensity: peach, melon, apricot and exotic fruits. The palate is also very intense with a long finish of minerality, with some light vanilla tones.

### ALSACE

- 7 Reserve Pinot Blanc** **£36.50**  
Cave de Turckheim  
A lovely hint of peachy colour from very ripe grapes with full, rich citrus and tropical fruit flavours and a long, slightly smoky finish.
- 8 Humbrecht Zind** **£42.50**  
Domaine Zind  
Bright pale yellow. Beautifully aromatic nose of citrus, wet stone and white fruits. Supple, juicy texture, well balanced with a sensational liveliness and mouth coating body. A wine of great character.



## LOIRE

- 9      **Muscadet Sur Lie**      **£31.00**  
Domaine de la Chauviniere  
Ripe fruit and savoury aromas with real Sur-lie character. The generous palate displays subtle stone fruit underscored by yeast while still displaying the textbook zest and balance.
- 10     **Andre Dezat et Fils Pouilly Fume**      **£45.00**  
Domaine Thibault  
Pale gold. Refined nose with toasted mineral notes, blackcurrant bud, wild flowers and pineapple. Archetypal Pouilly with a lovely crispness. Aromas unfurl and reveal themselves on the finish. Full, fresh, well-structured with lashings of minerality.
- 12     **Picpoul de Pinet**      **£32.00**  
Luvignac, Pomerols  
Complex aromas of gooseberry and citrus fruits. Fresh and fruity with a lengthy, lingering finish.

## ITALY

- 13     **Principessa Gavia Gavi D.O.C.G**      **£37.50**  
Castello Banfi, Piedmont  
Pale straw, offering an intense fruit forward bouquet, with typical hints of pineapple and apple. Well balanced with gentle acidity and a delicate dry finish.

## SPAIN

- 14     **Albarino 'Sobre Lias'**      **£41.00**  
Castro Martin, Rias Baixas  
A distinct salty minerality on the nose, and an array of pure, clean, limpid white fruit aromas. The palate almost shimmers with tang and vibrancy, and although it has a steely precision, it is balanced by fruit with a peachy pear-like quality and backed by a vivid streak of lemon and mineral acidity.
- 15     **Rioja Blanco**      **£29.50**  
Conde Valdemar, Rioja  
Intense aromas, with touches of white flowers, stone fruit and pear. Rounded on the palate with good acidity and a persistent length.

## PORTUGAL

- 16     **Manda-Chuva Branco 2020**      **£44.50**  
Herdade Do Portcarro, Alentejo  
On the nose the first impact is freshness, ripe citrus alongside grapefruit and tangerine. On the palate, the beginning is shy, a little closed. With the temperature rising, it starts to reveal all its mystique; mint with lime and a touch of salt. In between, one finds nectarines and loquats, a type of yellow plum. The Manda-Chuva has an admirable persistence, very gastronomic, like all Portocarro wines.

## GERMANY

- 17 **Gewürztraminer** £34.50  
Villa Wolf, Pfalz  
Classic notes of lychee, white tea and honeysuckle extend from the nose to finish in this gorgeously perfumed, fruity wine. Just a lip-smacking shade off dry, it's a juicy, exuberantly fresh sip that's perfect as an aperitif or with delicately spiced foods.
- 18 **Estate Riesling** £31.50  
Dr Loosen, Mosel  
Light, yet vibrant, with enticing aromas of white peach flowers and citrus peel. A dusting of pollen and saffron accentuate this bright, sunny Riesling full of peach and nectarine flavour. Off dry in style, juicy and thirst quenching, but structured with fresh revitalising acidity and mineral notes.

## AUSTRIA

- 19 **Gruner Veltliner** £37.50  
Hopler  
Intense varietal fruit flavours redolent of lemongrass and citrus fruits. The palate is refreshing with elegant fruit and crisp acidity.

## AUSTRALIA

- 20 **Windy Peak Chardonnay** £34.50  
De Bortoli, Yarra Valley  
Light straw with a green edge. Bright complex chardonnay with citrus florals, nutty oak, minerally and fine. Gently textured palate, savoury, chalky phenolics, hints of nuts, lovely balance.
- 21 **'Willowglen' Gewürztraminer Riesling** £29.00  
De Bortoli, Riverina  
A green tinge on a pale straw background. Heavy perfumed aromatics of musk and rosewater with complementing fresh spice and lime. A gorgeous, balanced palate of freshly dusted Turkish delight and lychee freshened by a fresh and zesty finish.
- 22 **'Enchanted Garden of the Eden Valley' Riesling** £48.50  
Dandelion Vineyards, Eden Valley  
Pale straw colour and delicate aromas of lime, lemon zest and blossoms. Vibrant and zesty on the palate, with notes of crisp green apple, juicy citrus and a touch of minerality, all balanced by a refreshing acidity.
- 23 **DJL Chardonnay** £52.50  
Xanadu, Margaret River  
Pale golden colour and enticing aromas of citrus fruits, white peaches, and a hint of toasty oak. On the palate, it delights with its medium to full bodied texture and a harmonious balance. Ripe tropical fruits, lemon zest, and a touch of vanilla create a rich and layered taste experience. Vibrant acidity, with a long creamy finish.

## SOUTH AFRICA

- 24 **'Slow' Chenin Blanc** £29.50  
False Bay, Western Cape  
Dried herbaceous notes, including fennel and aniseed, dominate the nose, followed up by a creamy lemon character and rich, textural finish.

## NEW ZEALAND

- 26     **'Inviniti' Sauvignon Blanc**     **£35.00**  
          Lawson Dry Hills, Marlborough  
An aromatic sauvignon blanc with passionfruit, citrus and freshly chopped grass. The palate is crisp and dry with concentrated fruit characteristics, making it the ideal refreshing wine.
- 27     **'Ten Rocks' Sauvignon Blanc**     **£34.50**  
          Lawson Dry Hills, Marlborough  
Displaying lifted grass and green capsicum aromatics along with lime and passion fruit. The palate is crisp and fresh with strong citrus flavours and a chalky mouthfeel. Good weight, lovely texture and a long finish.

**Tolpuddle Chardonnay 2021** Tasmania, Australia **£175.00**

A very exciting vintage. Quite expressive on the nose, with some lemon and quince notes. On the palate, there is breadth and power, and a sense that this will be a long living wine. The touch of opulence is reined in by the classic Tolpuddle Vineyard seam of acidity.

**Domaine Faiveley Batard Montrachet Grand Cru** Burgundy, France **£595.00**

An intensely aromatic nose disclosing notes of tart fruits and roasted hazelnut. The palate is smooth and distinctive with excellent balance and a remarkably smooth finish found in only the finest white Burgundies. This wine is evolving beautifully with bottle aging.

**Chateau de Fieuzal Grand Cru Classe de Graves 2013** Pessac-Leognan, France **£110.00**

Beautifully round and expressive. Smoke, scorched earth, tobacco and licorice add complexity to a core of dark black fruit. Dried flowers, sage and new leather linger on the finish.

**Chateau Pontet Canet 2004** Pauillac, Medoc, France **£195.00**

The bouquet delivers pure blackberry, pencil lead and tobacco notes that are more generous than other vintages. There is an element of dried herbs, a hint of black tar. The palate is medium bodied and quite sturdy in the mouth, the tannins strong but combined with intense earthy black fruit that round on the finish. A more classis, robust, earthy Pauillac.

**(92 points Wine Advocate)**

**Chateau Talbot 2005** Pauillac, Medoc, France **£295.00**

The 2005 Talbot is dense ruby/purple in colour, with moderately intense notes of forest floor, underbrush, and black and red currant fruit. It is slightly herbal, medium bodied, simple, but has good sweet fruit and a good finish.

**(89 points Wine Advocate)**

**Chateau Langoa Barton 2010** Pauillac, Medoc, France **£175.00**

Deep garnet in color, the 2010 Langoa Barton springs from the glass with notes of kirsch, black cherry compote and blueberry pie with touches of dried mint, pencil lead, tar and new leather. Medium to full-bodied, the palate has a rock-solid frame of ripe, grainy tannins and loads of freshness supporting the dense, muscular black and blue fruits, finishing with a minty kick.

**(92 points Wine Advocate)**

**Chateau Clos Fourtet 2004** St Emilion, France **£275.00**

Deep ruby in colour with purple reflections, and a subtle brightening on the rim. An inviting bouquet on the nose with delicate aromas of wild berries and liquorice, ripe cherry, orange zest and crystallised violets. The juicy, elegant palate is sweet and light on its feet, with fine tannins, fresh and mineral with subtle touch of caramel on the finish. Elegant and harmonious.

**Chateau Leoville Barton 2004** St Julien, Medoc, France **£230.00**

Comparable to the outstanding 1996, the more masculine style Leoville is always the star performer in the Barton brace. The nose is fine and displays multi faceted, lively fruit characteristics. The palate is dense with delicious, ripe, complex blackcurrant fruit and a fabulous, long cool finish. A star of the 2004 vintage.

**Chateau Brane Cantenac 2005** Margeaux, France **£400.00**

A sexy style of wine from the Lurons at Brane Cantenac, this wine has a stunning nose of forest floor, liquorice, blackcurrants, plums and spring flowers. Soft tannin, full-bodied opulence and beautifully textured, lush richness, make for a brilliant wine. In spite of its stunning forward fragrance and lushness, the colour still looks as if it is 3-4 years old, rather than a decade. This is a big time winner in 2005 and should drink well now and for the next 25+ years.

Deep garnet red. The nose is essentially fruity, with strong aromas of cassis and plums, with a touch of violets. This is an ample, well-rounded on the palate with balanced tannins and rounded mouthfeel.

Intense ruby red with garnet reflections. On the nose, almost ethereal, with rich dark fruit and a hint of vanilla. On the palate, full bodied, soft, velvety and intense, with hints of liquorice, spice and light goudron notes.

Pale to medium ruby purple in colour, the Forrest Pinot Noir offers up a nose of ripe black cherries and black raspberries complemented by hints of underbush and Provence herbs. Enormously concentrated, and perfectly balanced this wine is archetypical Fonseca.

Ruby red, wonderfully aromatic, packed with complex aromas of ripe red and dark fruits with floral undertones. On the palate typically Warre in style with tremendous elegance and finesse, packed with dark fruit flavours such as black cherry and plums, and silky tannins leading to a long lingering finish.
